

Network Planning: Introduction

Consider:

- Your vision outlined in your Leopold application
- Something you've worked on during the last 2 days
- An idea or project you have thought about

“Is there something you really want to develop and act on through the Leopold Program?”

Network Planning: First Step

Individually:

- Either:
 - Mind map a subject you want to work on
- Or:
 - Delve deeper into an existing subject and mind map
 - Objectives
 - Challenges etc

Network Planning: Process

Steps

- Write your project/idea at the center of a flipchart page
- On Post-It notes, write the names of key organizations and individuals with whom you are connected
- Place Post-It notes on the flipchart page to represent their position in the network
- Identify gaps and potential network partners, write on Post-It notes and place on flipchart (use different colours)
- Draw lines to make connections between contacts

Feedback from Fellows

Steps

- Organize into 4 groups
- Each Fellow gets 12 minutes to receive feedback from the group on their idea and network needs

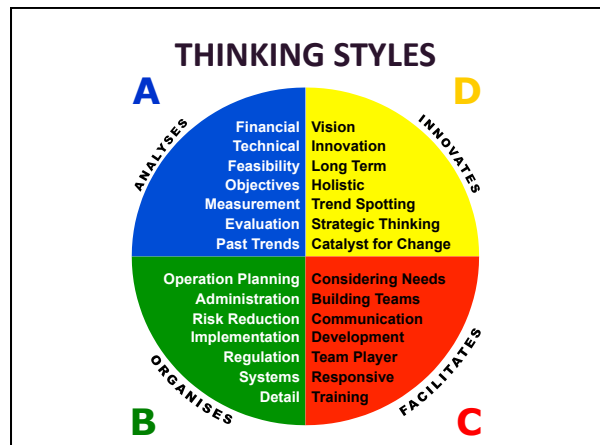

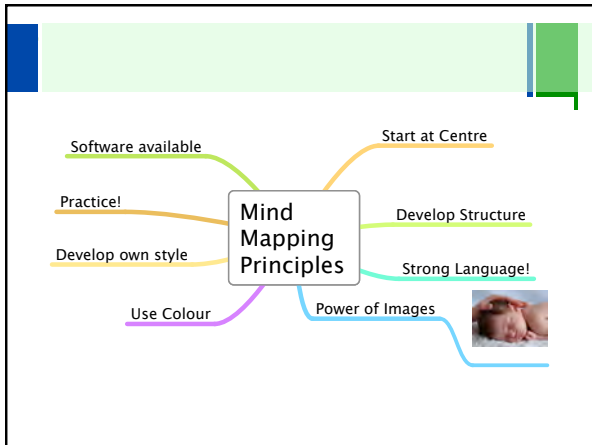

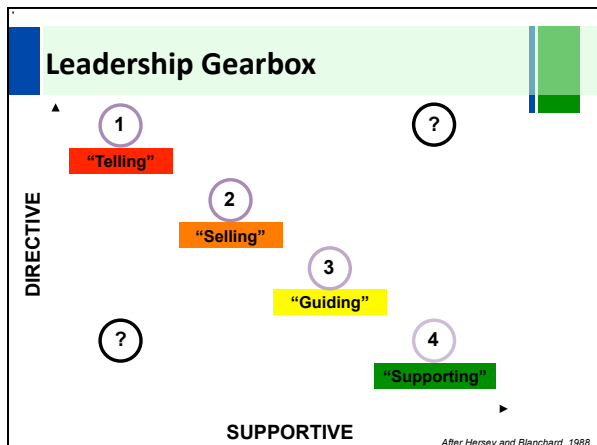
Strategic Thinking

Making the Switch

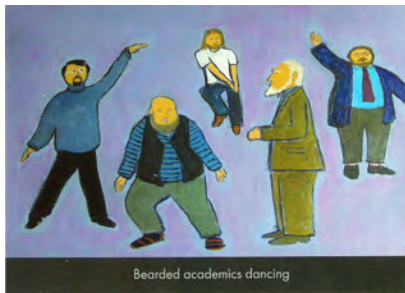
- For things to change, somebody somewhere has to start acting differently.
